I'm Ali, a fourth-generation knifemaker. Two masters raised me. Thanks to them, I learned both the traditional and modern styles of this work and by combining these styles, I made changes according to today's conditions and created new products. My great-grandfather and grandfather were hot iron masters, they made products using traditional methods. My father took the knife issue to a higher level by adding innovation to this business.

Now, I am working on a multi-layered Damascus. Especially, I use 15n20 and K720 Carbon Steel as material. On the other hand, I am beating by hand using completely traditional methods without using a Rammer. I use Damascus as middleware. Then, I make raindrop ladder patterns and Turkish twists, which are generally made worldwide.

One of my greatest wishes is to learn the method of extracting steel (Turkish name diced) from the ore with the quarry system you have used, use it with the Damascus I have made, and add innovations.
